2. Second, you will need to complete the form and send it to Rick Melone (his

information is on the form) to let us know how many meals and Titanic tickets you want to reserve. This must be completed and sent to Rick by June 1. If you want to include a deposit, please do so. Otherwise, just bring the total you owe with you to reunion.

We hope to have a great turnout and a fantastic time in Branson! I'm sure you will enjoy the accommodations, the food and the attractions, but you will love spending time with family the most. I also encourage you to bring items to auction, which helps us raise funds that we use to cover additional charges for reunion.
